

### SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM ANNOUNCEMENT

**Purpose.** To announce the annual Veteran College Scholarship opportunity for Veterans and other eligible persons.

#### Information

**General.** The Westbrook Village Veterans Club will award its next round of college scholarships to eligible Veterans (or eligible Veteran spouse/child) on May 30, 2025. This scholarship may be used for tuition, books, classroom supplies, room and board, and other direct or indirect fees levied by the educational institution coincident to college enrollment and attendance. Starting with this scholarship cycle, the announcement and application are combined into one document.

### Eligibility.

- JROTC senior year of high school
- ROTC Cadets
- Veterans with an Honorable Discharge
- Currently serving Military Reservists and National Guard
- Spouses, children and grandchildren of military personnel.

# **Proof of Eligibility**

• Veterans. DD-214

• **Reserve and National Guard.** Proof of current Reserve or National Guard service and obligation.

• **Spouse or child of a Veteran.** Proof of relationship to Service-member and proof of service US military service.

**Educational Verification.** Proof of current college or trade school attendance or acceptance and proof of beginning classes no later than September 1, 2025, at an accredited college, community college, junior college, or post-high school technical institute.

- May 1, 2024 Applications due
- June 6, 2024, Scholarship winners announced.
